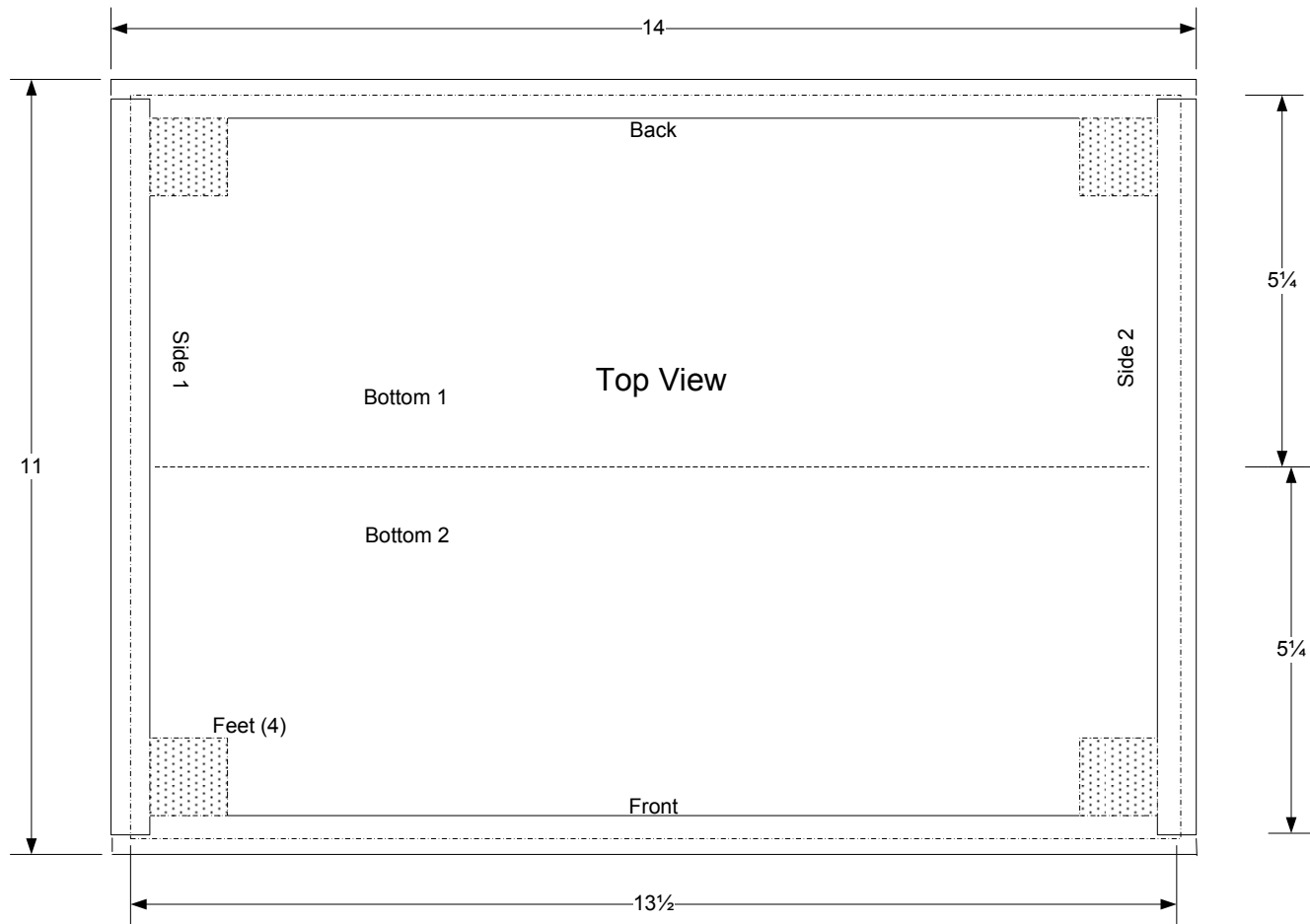


Stacking Desk Tray

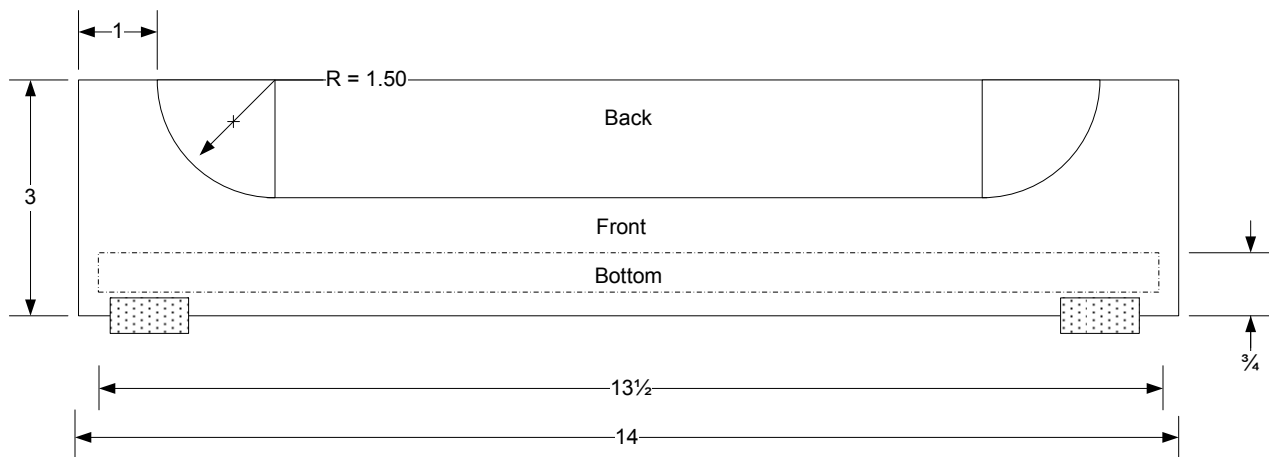
Woodworking Project

Bill of Materials (2 Trays)

(1) 6 1/4 x 106 x 1/2 (\$25-\$35)
Species: Oak, Walnut, Maple, Mahogany

Cut List (2 Trays)

Front/Back (4) 14 x 3 x 1/2
Sides (4) 10 1/2 x 3 x 1/2
Bottom (4) 13 1/2 x 5 1/4 x 1/2
Feet (8) 1 x 1 x 1/2

Instructions

1. Saw boards to size, sand.
2. Cut 1/2 wide x 1/4 deep rabbet in Front and Back pieces.
3. Cut 1/2 wide dado, 1/4 deep, 1/4 from bottom, all Sides, Front, Back.
4. Use Band Saw or Jig Saw to form Front feature. Drum sand.
5. Pre-fit assembly. Glue with tight clamps starting with Bottoms.
6. Sand, wipe, apply shellac, then stain and/or sealer, build finish with multiple coats of wipe-on clear gloss polyurethane.
